

Justification:

Having vehicles that are not readily identifiable as state vehicles is critical for AEDC in fulfilling its mission to bring business to Arkansas. Cars used by staff engaged in that part of our work have had waivers from official state license plates and seals, and will need to continue to have those waivers. Pool vehicles in our expanded pool fleet will also need waivers since they will be used for the same functions as those assigned to individual staff members.

Project Managers work with business prospects and consultants to recruit, expand and retain businesses in Arkansas. Their activities include site inspections and meetings throughout the state, and they often provide transportation to corporate officials and their consultants visiting potential business sites throughout Arkansas. They often visit a number of communities and they insist on anonymity especially during the initial phase of possible business location or expansion.




