

Additionally, please recall that Executive Order 10-14 requires State vehicles be used solely for purposes of official State business.

Is subject to call and responds to the Academy on all emergency and unusual events. Has the authority to make decisions on any issue involving public health, safety and the welfare of students, inmates, staff; to include escapes, misconduct or injury, building security, weather alarms, fire alarms, ADC searches of inmates, or to provide Academy assistance to any local, state or federal law enforcement agency.
