2001 - 2003

For the 2001-2003 Biennium, we are requesting the continuation of the Barber Examiners Stenographer (position#5).

We are asking for an appropriation increase in character 09 to purchase additional software and to provide training of new software in order for the office to maintain up to date technology, therefore supporting new programs as they are deemed necessary for the future. We are also requesting an appropriation increase in character 02 for Centrex service (telephone) as an additional phone line is necessary to accommodate our fax machine and a line dedicated specifically for the computer.

We will need an appropriation increase in character 02 to cover an estimated rise in postage and rent as the office space in the building we are currently renting is to be destroyed and we are to move in the year of 2001. An appropriation increase in character 02 is needed to cover employees and board members who travel in and out of state due to the rising cost each year in hotel accommodations.

We are requesting additional appropriation in character 11 to replace office equipment and furniture as it is deemed necessary.

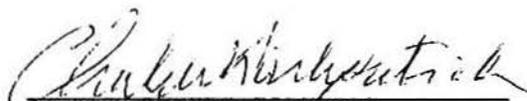

**ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM
ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST
2001 - 2003**

The State Board of Barber Examiners was created by Act 313 of 1937 to regulate the Barbering Profession. The Board supervises the Barber Colleges in Arkansas to insure that they teach the proper methods of sanitation, sterilization, and perform services to the public. The Board prepares written and practical examinations and administers them to the students upon completion of the course. Upon passage, students are licensed to work in a licensed barber shop.

The Board issues Student Barber, Barber, Technician, Barber Shop, Barber Instructor, and Barber College Licenses. Barber Shops are inspected periodically, by direction of the Board, to make sure the barbers have a current license and are using the proper method of sterilization and sanitation.

Base Level includes a cost of living increase of 2.6% each year over the FY01 salary levels, related Personal Services Matching costs, two Extra Help positions, and supporting Maintenance & General Operations. The Agency is requesting the continuation of the Barber Examiners Stenographer position for the Biennium. The Agency is also requesting an increase of \$3,000 each year in Operating Expenses to cover additional software, centrex services, postage, and rent. An increase of \$300 each year for Conference Fees and Travel is to cover training of the new software purchased. An increase of \$500 each year in Capital Outlay is to replace office equipment and furniture as necessary.
