8/27/2015	Arkansas Geological Survey	Reservoir Characterization and Resource Assessment of Upper Jurassic Smackover Formation, South Arkansas. The primary objectives of the proposed project are 1) to examine the existing research literatures and collect the geological information on evaluating the reservoir characteristics of the Upper Smackover in South Arkansas; 2) to conduct burial history, thermal maturation history and expulsion history analyses in South Arkansas through basin and determine the hydrocarbon generation depths and the timing of generation and expulsion; 3) to recognize and describe the kerogen type and richness of the Smackover Formation and other potential source rocks; 4) to perform resource assessment of the oil and gas resources in reservoirs of the South Arkansas area, and to use the petroleum system based resource assessment for estimating the volume of the resource that are available for potential recovery; 5) to digitize the selected electronic logs of wells which penetrate into the Smackover Formation; and 6) to establish a well database including information of stratigraphic tops on key intervals.
