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JAG Special Purpose Mini Grant Program f/k/a Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program (LLEBG)

Program Funding Period: Varies

### RE: Allowable Use of Grant Funds

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LLEBG funds are made available to cities and counties to support law enforcement agencies.

- Purchases must be law enforcement related.
- No weapons or ammunition may be purchased with grant funds (includes stun guns / taser devices).

The following is a general list of possible allowable purchases:

## RE: Clarification Regarding the Use of JAG Grant Funds

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### Supplanting

Funds may **not** be used to supplant locally appropriated funds in current budgets. In other words, JAG funds should not be used to take the place of existing local funds already set aside for proposed purchases.

### Purchases

Federal funds may not be paid to any agent or officer for expenses incurred. Approved items must be purchased directly from vendors. Subgrantee officials may **not** use personal credit cards and receive personal reimbursement.

### Uniforms

Grant funds will not be approved for purchases of civilian clothing for undercover or any other purpose. Approved uniforms should be official public safety apparel such as Class A uniforms, specialized tactical wear, including Hazmat and items displaying the entity logo.

## **PROHIBITED PURCHASES**

### Weapons and Related Items

It is the determination of the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Coordinating Council along with DFA that JAG funds will **not** be used to support weapons and ammunition. Tasers will also be included in this prohibition.

Other Prohibited Expenses:

Vehicles other than police cruisers (SUVs, Trucks, Vans, etc.)

Luxury items

Real estate

Construction projects

Military Surplus Items
