COAP CATEGORY 2 -REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS (RFA)**

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DFA-IGS has a total of \$4,600,000 in grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-based Program grant, funded through the Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act (CARA) that is available to address the opioid epidemic in the State. This funding is being made available to assist localities and jurisdictions in developing programs that will address the opioid epidemic through investigations as well as identify individuals with opioid use disorders as well as family members to engage in treatment and peer recovery services. Subawards will be based on the availability of funding. Subawards are to be issued according to the application scoring and the requested budget amount.

**AVAILABLE FUNDING:**

Budget requests must not exceed \$200,000 for a project period of 24-months. Subawards will be granted to 6 different geographical areas/jurisdictional areas of the State. This grant opportunity does not require a match.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

Eligible applicants are law enforcement units that operate in the State of Arkansas that have been identified as targeted areas of high need (See RFA Instructions for more details on eligibility requirements.).

**APPLICATION DEADLINE:**

Applications and supporting documentations are due by 12:00 p.m. Central Standard Time **Monday, June 1, 2020** to Department of Finance and Administration-Intergovernmental Services.
