NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

The State of Arkansas, Department of Finance and Administration - Intergovernmental Services (IGS) announces the availability of funding under the U.S. Department of Justice's Office of Justice Programs' (OJP) Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) FFY2020 Comprehensive Opioid Stimulants Substance Abuse Program (COSSAP) and the FFY 2020 Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Program for State Prisoners (RSAT). Potential applicants should carefully review the state solicitation for program requirements before submitting a proposal.

<u>PURPOSE</u>: To support, develop, and implement a residential substance abuse treatment for Arkansas prisoners in state and local correctional and detention facilities as well as to create and maintain community-based aftercare services for offenders.

PROJECT PERIOD: October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2023 (24-Month Project)

Applicants are limited to state agencies, units of local government, law enforcement districts, and judicial enforcement districts. Applying entities **must** operate and/or maintain correctional or detention facilities for incarcerated individuals and able to comply with the match requirement of 25%.

PROPOSAL DEADLINE:

Proposals and supporting documentations are due by 4:30 p.m. Central Standard Time on **Thursday, October 28, 2021** to Department of Finance and Administration-Intergovernmental Services. Proposals submitted by mail should be postmarked no later than October 28, 2021.
