ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM AGENCY PROGRAM COMMENTARY 1999 - 2001

Act 208 of 1979 created the Court of Appeals and provided for 6 judges to be elected to 8-year terms from districts across the state. Because of the increasing number of appeals filed with the Court of Appeals, the 1993 legislature passed Act 1085 which increased the number of sitting judges on the Court from 6 to 12 effective July 1, 1995. The Court's budget and 95-97 appropriation reflected the additional funding and positions the Court anticipated it would need to staff and equip the 6 additional judgeships created by Act 1085. Act 1085 was later amended by Act 11 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1995. Act 11 provided that the Court of Appeals would continue to be consist of 6 judges until January 1, 1996, at which time the Court would be composed of 9 judges until January 1, 1997, when the Court would be increased to 12 judges. Pursuant to Act 11, the Court has been composed of 12 judges since January 1, 1997. Because the 81st General Assembly adjourned without determining the number and location of the Court of Appeals districts from which the qualified electors of these districts would elect (at the November 1998 general election) the six judges to take office January 1, 1999, the six judges appointed pursuant to Act 11 continue to hold office.

For the 1999-01 biennium, the Court is seeking an increase in Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching.

<u>Regular Salaries</u>. The salary requests for FY 99-00 and FY 00-01 include a 2.8% increase each year above the appropriated level. Additionally, the Court is eliminating a Grade 15 secretarial position, which has not been filled since it was appropriated, and the Court's requested appropriation reflects a \$25,000 decrease for the elimination of this position.

Extra Help. Request is the same as the FY 98-99 authorized appropriation.

Personal Services Matching is being requested in proportion to the additional salary requests for FY 99-00 and FY 00-01. The FY 99-00 amount is \$566,126. The FY 00-01 amount is \$581,975.

Maintenance and Operation. The Court's maintenance and operation request has been increased from its FY 98-99 appropriation by \$12,413 for FY 99-00. This increase includes an \$8,913 increase for Internet and legal research access for the judges and law clerks and a one-time \$3,500 increase for modem purchases and modem line installation.

Special Judges. This request has not increased from the Court's FY 98-99 appropriation of \$42,025.

Court-appointed Attorneys. This request has been increased to \$100,000 because of the increasing legal fees awarded attorneys and the increase in the Court's criminal docket.


Conference and Travel. This request has not increased from the Court's FY 98-99 appropriation of \$44,000.

Capital Outlay. This request has not increased from the Court's FY 98-99 appropriation of \$45,500.

With the recommendation of this budget, the Court of Appeals will be able to continue reviewing in an orderly and just fashion the cases appealed from circuit, chancery, juvenile, and probate courts, along with appeals from the Arkansas Public Service Commission, the Workers' Compensation Commission, the Employment Security Division, and other administrative agencies.
