ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM AGENCY PROGRAM COMMENTARY 1997 - 1999

The Office of Prosecutor Coordinator (PCO), under the direct guidance and supervision of the Prosecution Coordination Commission, provides a broad range of support services to Arkansas' 180 prosecutors and deputies. Services include maintaining a "crisis center" for emergency research for prosecutors at trial, conducting general research for prosecutors at their request, and providing continuing legal education seminars on current topics in criminal law and county government. PCO represents the state in approximately 2,500 civil and criminal commitment hearings a year at the State Hospital; administers the Victims of Crime Act, Violence Against Women Act, and the Family Violence and Prevention Services Act federal grant programs; and provides training and technical assistance for victim/witness advocates and crime victim services providers.

CRIME VICTIM ASSISTANCE ACT ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF- Additional appropriation is requested to accommodate the additional funding provided by the Department of Justice. This program provides subgrants to crime victim service organizations. Due to the increased size and scope of this program an additional part-time position is requested to assist with the administration of this program.

VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN ACT ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF-Additional appropriation is requested to accommodate additional funding provided by this 100% federally funded program. This addition will provide for administrative costs involved in the administration of the subgrant program and for costs in providing technical assistance and training to prosecutors.

USER SUPPORT ANALYST - PCO is requesting additional appropriation for each year of the biennium for salary and matching costs for a User Support Analyst. PCO currently has only one computer support person who attempts to staff and maintain systems in over 40 offices. All prosecutors except the Little Rock office are on one system. This position will assist in revamping the case

management and hot check system. This program will provide technical support to enable prosecutorial staff to utilize a tailored software document imaging program. The capacity for efficient record retrieval is essential to the effective prosecution of violent or career criminals, particularly where large case loads overwhelm prosecutorial staff. Expanded manual systems do not resolve the problem. Similarly, one-of-a-kind automated information systems are costly and hinder the exchange of data among prosecutors, research and other criminal justice agencies, thus preventing coordination of operational and research activities.

RENT - The Office of Prosecutor is requesting \$1,500 for rent for each year of the biennium to provide for a 4% rent increase which will take place. While rent on this space has increased for the last 10 years, this is the first request for increase this office has made.

AFGM - PCO is requesting \$2,800 for each year of the biennium to support the installation and utilization related to agency incorporation of the automated Accounting Federal Grants Management System. This system would eliminate the need for DF&A agencies to re- key submitted information such as accounts payable and inventory control. It would also provide viable information to this agency daily that is now only provided on a monthly basis. Utilization of this system would greatly enhance and expedite all functions of the fiscal officer.

REPAIR & REPLACEMENT OF COMPUTERS - PCO's capitol request each year of the biennium will allow for the maintenance and repair of systems utilized to manage the hot check recovery program throughout the state. Most of the equipment has been in place since the 1980's and with the rapid advances in technology, and short life of data processing equipment, there is a need to replace some computers each year. It is difficult to meet the needs of current users, as well as fulfill additional requests to expand equipment placement at current budgeted levels.

This appropriation is the main operating appropriation for the agency. The Office of Prosecutor Coordinator is requesting \$490,336 for FY98 and \$501,297 for FY99. Of these amounts, the priority programs component totals \$34,221 for FY98 and \$34,974 for FY99. The primary priority request consists of salary and associated matching costs of \$29,921 for FY98 and \$30,674 for FY99 for a Grade 20 User Support Analyst. Among other duties, the Analyst position will allow the agency to overhaul the case management and hot check system to enable prosecutorial staff to run on a tailored document imaging and software program. According to the agency, this will serve to improve the coordination of operational and research activities.

The Office of Prosecutor Coordinator is also requesting additional operational support in the amount of \$4,300 each year of the biennium for the following: (1) \$1,500 each year to accommodate an increase in facility rent; and (2) \$2,800 each year to support installation and utilization costs related to agency incorporation of the automated Accounting Federal Grants Management (AFGM) System. Incorporation of this system would permit the agency to key such data as accounts payable vouchers and inventory control information and allow daily monitoring of many aspects of the agency's fiscal operations. This appropriation is funded entirely from the State Central Services Fund.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level, which includes appropriation for a 2.8% Cost of Living Allowance for positions on July 1 of each year of the biennium along with accompanying employee matching requirements. The Executive further recommends \$4,300 each year to support a facility rent increase and utilization costs related to incorporation of the automated AFGM System.

The priorities requested would provide salary and matching totaling \$16,252 for FY98 and \$16,665 for FY99 for a part-time Grade 21 Victim Witness Coordinator to assist in the administration of the Crime Victim Assistance Act. Additional M & O support totaling \$35,000 each year is requested to accommodate the M & O costs associated with this program. The most substantial increase is \$548,748 for FY98 and \$548,335 for FY99 for additional subgrant support for crime victim service organizations.

The Office of Prosecutor Coordinator requests \$1,500,000 each year of the 1997-99 biennium for funds anticipated to be provided by the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Program. This program receives funding through the U.S. Department of Justice. The primary focus of the program is to strengthen and develop effective law enforcement and prosecution strategies and victim services in cases involving violent crimes against women. The priority program component of this request totals \$984,064 for FY98 and \$982,981 for FY99. The agency is requesting four (4) priority positions to perform the administrative duties of this program. These positions are: (a) Grade 25 Attorney Specialist, (b) two (2) Grade 24 Attorneys, and (c) a part-time Grade 21 Victim/Witness Coordinator. Total salary and matching costs for these positions total \$134,559 for FY98 and \$138,034 for FY99. Additional M & O and Administrative Expenses support totaling \$94,150 each year is requested to cover the administrative costs of this program as well as provide technical assistance and training to prosecutors. Priority requests totaling \$753,355 for FY98 and \$748,797 for FY99 is requested for VAWA Grants/Aids to be used to promote victim services.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level, which includes appropriation for a 2.8% Cost of Living Allowance for positions on July 1 of each year along with accompanying employee matching requirements. The Executive further recommends salary and accompanying personal services matching support for one (1) Grade 24 Attorney position. M & O support associated with this position is also recommended totaling \$11,550 each year.
