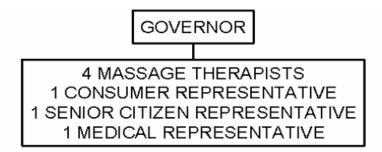
Act 19 of 2003 A.C.A. §19-5-1215

History and Organization

The Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy was created with the intent to upgrade the standards of practice and education of massage therapy and regulate the practice of massage therapy in the State of Arkansas.

The Board consists of seven (7) members appointed by the Governor for a term of three years. Four members are licensed to practice massage therapy. One member represents the elderly, one member represents the public, and one member represents the medical field.

The Board has statutory authority to examine and inspect all massage therapy schools, offices, and clinics in the State. The Board is required to hold at least one examination each year, and may hold other examinations from time to time. Certificates of registration are issued annually for Massage Therapists, Massage Therapy Instructors, Massage Therapy Schools, and Massage Therapy Offices or Clinics. Registration certificates are issued annually and expire on June 30 of each year.



Agency Commentary

The Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy is requesting an increase in Operating Expenses in the amount of \$3,750 each year of the biennium. The rent is increasing from \$300 a month to \$800 a month with all the utilities paid. The Board is requesting an increase in rent of \$5,500, a decrease in electricity of \$1,500, and a decrease in water and sewage of \$250 each year of the biennium. The Board is requesting a salary increase to \$35,000 in FY06 and to \$38,500 for FY07 for the Executive Secretary.

Analysis of Budget Request

Appropriation / Program: 428 - Massage Board Operations

Funding Sources: MMT-Massage Therapy Board

The Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy was created to upgrade the standards of practice and education of massage therapy and regulate the practice of massage therapy in the State of Arkansas. The Board has statutory authority to examine and inspect all massage therapy schools, offices, and clinics in the State. The Board is required to hold at least one examination each year, and may hold other examinations from time to time. Certificates of registration are issued annually for Massage Therapists, Massage Therapy Schools, and Massage Therapy offices or clinics.

Base Level for this appropriation includes graduated salary increases of 3% to 1.5% each year over FY05 salary levels, along with related Personal Services Matching costs for one (1) Base Level position. Included in Personal Services Matching is a \$40 increase in the monthly contribution for State employee's health insurance for a total State match of \$320 per month.

Agency is requesting Base Level of \$75,340 in FY06 & \$76,417 in FY07 plus Change Level requests totaling \$9,168 for FY06 & \$12,251 for FY07. Requests include \$3,500 each year for increases in postage and mileage. The increase is postage is for additional licensee's mail outs. The number of Licensed Massage Therapist has doubled from 1000 to 2000 registered licensees in the past two years. An increase in mileage for the board members is requested in Travel Expense due to the board meetings being moved to Little Rock. An Extraordinary Salary Increase for the Therapy Technology Secretary is being requested in the amount of \$5,668 for FY06 and \$8,751 in FY07 due to a substantial increase in work load, hours, and responsibilities.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Agency Request in Operations and adjusts the Extraordinary Salary Increase to an increase of \$4,631 for FY06 and \$4,771 for FY07.
