ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM AGENCY PROGRAM COMMENTARY 2001 - 2003

The Arkansas Towing & Recovery Board is a cash fund agency which receives its revenues from penalties accessed for violations, late filing fees, and fees for the license and vehicle safety permit issued to towing businesses.

The Board's operating expenditures have increased due to the large numbers of consent and non-consent towing businesses coming into compliance and because of the increased collaboration with law enforcement agencies. The Board will also have to reorder non-consent vehicle safety permits and the year tabs for its permit renewals.

The Board needs an additional appropriation for professional consulting services to help keep the members and their staff informed on procedural changes and issues effecting consumers pertaining to the towing industry as well as the towing industry itself.

With the new statewide system, AASIS, the Board will need additional funds to upgrade its current program basis as well as acquire new programs to assist in the computerizing the current manual processes in the office. In addition, the Board is in the process of establishing a website/page, additional monies will be needed in maintaining current information on this site as well as for the initial setup.

The current reserves and the projected revenues generated from the license and permit fees, late filing fees and the penalties paid by the members of the towing industry are believed to be sufficient to cover the Towing and Recovery Board's budget request.

ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST 2001 - 2003

The Towing and Recovery Board is a cash fund agency established under Arkansas Code Annotated §27-50-1203 to regulate Arkansas's towing industry. The Board is responsible for promulgating and administering rules and regulations for the industry, establishing licensing, insurance and safety equipment requirements for towing and related services and establishing tow truck safety requirements for vehicles utilized for commercial purposes. The Board issues towing business licenses and tow vehicle safety permits, assesses fees for late filings and investigates allegations of violations. Funding is derived from fees levied on towing businesses. To effectively carry out the duties and mission of the agency, the Board is requesting additional appropriation in the 2001-03 biennial budget.

The Agency requests a Base Level of \$95,393 in FY02 and \$96,588 in FY03 which includes two (2) employees and a 2.6% payplan increase and Personal Services Matching above FY01 salary level. Change Levels include increases totaling \$3,623 and \$1,680 respectively each year of the biennium for Operating Expenses. Requests for increases include items such as telephone and data processing software directly related to Information Technology, printing costs, rent for non-state owned building space, and for the purchase of office machines. A request for an increase of \$4,200 each year of the biennium for Professional Fees and Services is made to help keep the Board informed of issues pertaining to the towing industry. Additional Capital Outlay is requested in the amount of \$1,500 each year for computer purchases.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level and the Agency Request for Operating Expenses totaling \$3,623 in FY02 and \$1,680 in FY03 and \$1,500 each year of the biennium for Capital Outlay.
