The Fire Protection Licensing Board will be working with licensed companies helping them understand the state, local and national fire codes. We feel by helping to educate the installers and servicing companies, as well as the general public, we will help to provide quality fire protection for a reasonable price.

The members of the Fire Protection Licensing Board intend to do what we can to protect and promote public safety by minimizing personal injury and property damages which result from improperly installed or improperly maintained fire protection systems and upgrading National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) pamphlets, from which the installation, servicing and maintaining of portables, fixed systems and fire protection sprinkler systems regulations are derived.

With the addition of the investigator/inspector we are able to check companies, thus making sure that they are in compliance with the rules/regulations of the State of Arkansas. We also respond to any compliant that is received regarding a company or system that is out of compliance or anyone who fails to abide by the laws of the State of Arkansas.

Every company that wishes to work in the State of Arkansas must be licensed with this board. Renewals are a way we have of constantly checking companies to make sure that they have proper tags, insurance, etc.

Priority requests include an increase for rent, FY98 and FY99 for \$1,200, due to the rent increases we have experienced for the past two years and a request for \$3,700 in FY98 to purchase office equipment, such as new telephones.

#### ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST 1997 - 1999

Created by Act 743 of 1977, the Arkansas Fire Protection Licensing Board strives to help protect the public through the certification and licensing of individuals and companies who install and service fire extinguishers and sprinkler systems. This cash agency receives its income from fees charged for examinations and renewals. The Board has two positions, operating expenses, conference fees and travel, and professional fees and services.

Priority requests for the biennium are \$1,200 each year of the biennium for increases in rent and \$3,700 in FY98 to purchase office equipment.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level, which includes appropriation for a 2.8% Cost of Living Allowance for positions on July 1 of each year of the biennium along with accompanying employee matching requirements.

Expenditure of appropriation is dependent upon available funding.
