The Board has requested additional professional fees for investigative services; operating expenses for rent increases and inflation; capital outlay to upgrade their computer system; conference fees and travel for increased travel expenses to conferences, as well as an extraordinary salary increase for the Executive Director to bring the salary up to an equivalent level to that of other boards with similar positions.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level, but does not reflect the extraordinary increase requested for the Executive Director position at this time.

Expenditure of appropriation is dependent upon available funding.
