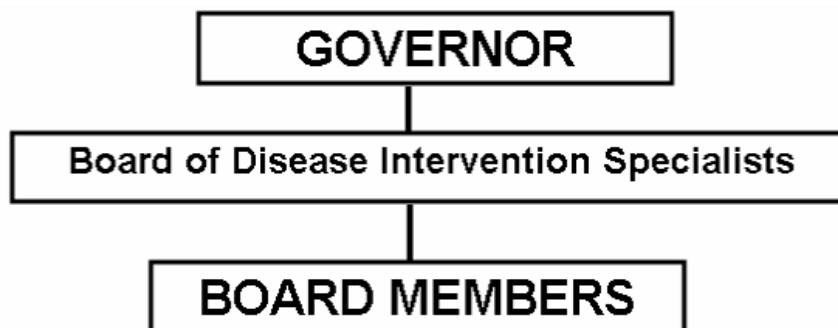
## Enabling Laws

Act 26 of 2003  
A.C.A. §17-98-101 et. seq.

## History and Organization

The State Board of Disease Intervention Specialists was created by Act 107 of 1993 as a seven member board to provide for the registration of Disease Intervention Specialists.

Its purpose is to protect the public by setting standards of qualification, training and experience for those who represent themselves to the public as Disease Intervention Specialists. This is done by promoting high standards of training for those in the field. Further, the Board can administer examinations and collect fees from individuals interested in becoming Registered Disease Intervention Specialists.



## Agency Commentary

The Board licenses and regulates specialists across the State who educate, investigate, and counsel individuals infected with or exposed to sexually transmitted diseases or HIV. The budget request of the State Board of Disease Intervention Specialists for the 2005-2007 is Base Level and will be funded entirely by cash revenues collected pursuant Act 107 of 1993.

The State Board of Disease Intervention Specialists is funded from the receipt of fees charged by the Agency, as authorized by Arkansas Code §17-98-107. The Board licenses and regulates the Disease Intervention Specialists across the State, who educate, investigate, and counsel individuals infected or exposed to sexually transmitted diseases or HIV.

The Board has requested a Base Level budget for each year of the 2005-2007 biennium. The Base Level request is for \$2,479 each year for Operating Expenses.
