## AGENCY PROGRAM COMMENTARY 2001 - 2003

Receipts from license fees charged by the agency finance the Arkansas State Board of Nursing operations. The Board is statutorily responsible for the licensing, examination, certification, endorsement, education, discipline and regulation of over 46,000 nurses and has more than sufficient fund balance to accommodate the requests described herein. The agency is operating in a highly efficient manner. In comparison with other states in the region, project expense as a percent of budget is the second lowest in the region and the ratio of numbers of licensees to each staff person is the second highest in the region. In order to execute the Board's responsibilities and fulfill the Board's public protection mission, seven budget change requests are imperative.

An emergency supplemental secretary position was approved in 1999 to implement requirements of Act 1208 of 1999, criminal background checks and to meet the over 150% increase in disciplinary demands on the agency in the last five years. The Board requests this position be converted to a permanent position. Implementing 1999 legislative requirements for criminal background checks (Act 1208), entering the Board into an interstate compact (Act 220) for mutual recognition of nurse licensure with ten other states, and replacement of funds diverted for previously approved supplemental positions has drained the operating budget. Additional funds (\$32,500 – 35,000) are requested to be appropriated from the agency's revenue to meet these demands. Over ninety-nine percent of the operating expenses were expended in the previous fiscal year, therefore, carry forward authority is requested in the special language request.

An appropriation of the agency's fund is requested to implement a continuing education (CE) requirement for nurse license renewal. All other Arkansas health professionals and 32 other states require CE for licensure renewal. Appropriation to increase salaries of three staff positions which include a nurse, computer specialist and nursing administrative assistant are requested to more equitably bring into line these positions with other staff in the same positions in the agency and market compensation.

A request for appropriation of the agency's revenue to establish a database regarding nursing workforce needs and to establish a scholarship program to assist in alleviating the nursing shortage is included. At least 25 letters from universities, hospitals and organizations around the state were received asking the Board to implement this proposal.

Thirty-two states have a chemical dependency program to remove impaired nurses from practice quickly and require treatment and monitoring before reentry to practice. This eliminates the approximate five-month delay in getting the case investigated and a hearing set before the impaired nurse is taken out of practice. The Board requests an appropriation from the agency's fund balance to establish such a program.

The Arkansas Board of Nursing is proud to have been named the outstanding Board of Nursing by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing. This national award was given because of the improvements made in public protection over the last few years that were approved by the Governor and Arkansas Legislature. Approval of these requests will align the Arkansas Board of Nursing's appropriation with budgets for Boards of Nursing in surrounding states who have similar numbers of licensees.

## ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST 2001-2003

The State Board of Nursing is funded from the receipt of fees charged by the Agency, as authorized by Arkansas Code §17-87-306. The Agency requests Base Level of \$1,209,474 for FY02 and \$1,230,023 for FY03 that includes salaries and personal services matching for sixteen positions and supporting maintenance and operating expenses. Base Level includes a payplan increase of 2.6% each year over the 2001 fiscal year salary levels for all incumbents plus appropriate Personal Services Matching costs. Changes totaling \$608,916 in FY02 and \$643,033 in FY03 have been requested. Of the total change requests, \$139,982 in FY02 and \$138,419 in FY03 relates to ongoing operations. The balance, or \$468,934 in FY02 and \$504,614 in FY03 corresponds to new initiatives being proposed by the Board.

The new initiatives are contingent on certain legislation being passed by the 83<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly. The first initiative is to implement three new programs within the Nursing board. The first program will allow the Board to perform **criminal background checks** as a prerequisite to nursing licensure. Act 1208 of 1999 was enacted mandating the Board to require criminal background checks but no appropriation was provided. The second program establishes a **Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Certification (SANE**). This certification will apply to registered nurses with advanced, specialized training in caring for victims of sexual assault. The third program will establish a **Continuing Competence Program** for nurses similar to competence programs for other health care professionals. Change requests related to these new programs include the addition of two positions at a salary cost of \$77,500 in FY02 and \$79,515 in FY03 plus personal service matching. Additional operating expenses of \$36,224 in FY02 and \$34,300 in FY03 have also been requested. Information Technology requests related to this initiative are \$8,490 in FY02 and \$2,155 in FY03.

The second initiative will implement two new programs within the Board of Nursing. The first program establishes a **nursing** workforce data base to collect, analyze and report data regarding Arkansas nursing workforce needs. To appropriately address the nursing manpower crisis, accurate and timely data about the nursing workforce is imperative. The second program will establish a **nursing scholarship program** to assist in alleviating the nursing shortage. This program will establish scholarships for nursing students in nursing programs throughout the State. Change requests related to these new programs include the addition of three positions at a salary cost of \$104,000 each year of the biennium plus personal service matching. Additional operating expenses of \$36,586 in FY02 and \$33,400 in FY03 will be required. Information Technology related to this initiative is \$18,333 in FY02 and \$2,770 in FY03.

The last initiative is implementation of an alternative to discipline program for impaired nurses. The intent of this program is to

provide a voluntary alternative to traditional disciplinary action. Implementation of this program will require the addition of two new positions in the first year of the biennium at a cost of \$83,483 plus matching and up to five additional positions in the second year of the biennium at a cost of \$125,160 plus matching costs. Operating expense additions are estimated to be \$27,750 in FY02 and \$22,250 in FY03 for this program. Information Technology requests for FY02 are \$8,890 and \$13,570 in FY03.

Change Level requests for ongoing operations include the addition of one position that was previously approved as a supplemental position. This position is critical to fulfilling a 1999 Federal mandate to report disciplinary actions. Salary cost for this position, including matching is \$40,132 in FY02 and \$41,098 in FY03. Operating expense increases of \$25,500 in FY02 and \$29,000 in FY03 have been requested to offset anticipated increases in rental cost of non-state owned office space, lab fees, Board member expenses and other operating costs. Increases to Professional Fees and Services of \$5,000 each year of the biennium have been requested for costs associated with the interstate licensure compact. A \$1,500 increase in Capital Outlay each year of the biennium is being requested for replacement of outdated office equipment and a microfiche/printer. Technology requests related to ongoing operations is \$38,092 in FY02 and \$31,392 in FY03. The ongoing technology request by line item includes Operating Expense increases of \$16,592 in FY02 and \$16,192 in FY03; Conference Fees and Travel increases of \$5,000 in FY02 and \$2,700 in FY03; Professional Fees and services increases of \$2,000 each year of the biennium; Capital Outlay increases of \$11,000 in FY02 and \$7,000 in FY03; and Data Processing increases of \$3,500 each year of the biennium. The Board is also requesting salary upgrades for key employees of \$21,146 in FY02 and \$21,817 in FY03. Extra help for seasonal workload requirements of \$8,612 each year of the biennium has also been requested. In summary, the total requested increase related to ongoing operations is \$139,982 in FY02 and \$138,419 in FY03.

The Executive Recommendation addresses the portion of the Agency request related to ongoing operations only. The portions of the request related to new initiatives are not recommended pending actions of the 83<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly. Accordingly, the Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level and additional salary and matching of \$40,132 in FY02 and \$41,098 in FY03 for the conversion of one supplemental emergency position. For the non-technology portion of the ongoing agency request, the Executive recommendation provides for Operating Expense increases of \$25,500 in FY02 and \$29,000 in FY03; Professional Fees and Services increases of \$5,000 each year of the biennium; and a \$1,500 increase in Capital Outlay in each year of the biennium. The Executive Recommendation for ongoing Technology requests provides for increases of \$24,092 in FY02 and \$29,892 in FY03. Finally, the Executive Recommendation provides for salary upgrades totaling \$9,073 in FY02 and \$9,311 in FY03. The total Executive Recommendation provides for increases of \$105,297 in FY02 and \$115,801 in FY03.
