Enabling Laws

Act 19 of 2005 A.C.A. §17-90-201 thru 306 A.C.A. §17-90-401

History and Organization

Functions of the Board involve administering examinations to doctors who wish to practice optometry in Arkansas. Every Doctor of Optometry has to renew his or her license to practice optometry in Arkansas each year. This involves the doctors reporting to the Board the number of hours of continuing education they have received during the year, and paying the license renewal fee. The Board requires each doctor to have obtained at least twelve hours of continuing education during the year to renew the license.

The Board of Optometry must approve the courses, seminars, and conferences that are available to Doctors of Optometry in order for the hours available at these meetings to be acceptable toward license renewal in Arkansas.

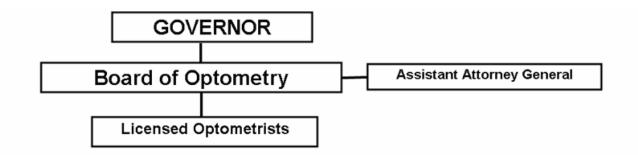
The Board of Optometry also issues a duplicate license to be displayed at each branch office at which an optometrist works. In addition to the branch office license, the Board issues Corporation Licenses and Drug Certificates each year.

The Board has seven members, consisting of five optometrists and two public members. The Governor appoints each for a term of five years. The Board contracts with a legal officer. This has been approved by the Attorney General's office.

In 1978, the courts said it was legal for professional persons to advertise their services. This has created problems for all Boards with regard to advertising that is false and misleading. The Board of Optometry has set guidelines for advertising that helps keep the public from being misled.

In 1997, the optometry law was changed to allow optometrist to prescribe oral medications and controlled substances. This new law also required the optometrists to receive more continuing education each year and pass a test to become an optometric physician. Only optometrists with the qualifications of an optometric physician can practice at the higher level. The requirements for license renewal as an optometric physician require at least (20) twenty hours of continuing education each year.

The Board of Optometry is required by statute to meet at least twice annually, but meetings are held at least every three months. Except for the meeting to administer the board examinations, the meetings are held in the Office of the Attorney General. Currently the Board licenses 395 optometrists.



Agency Commentary

The Board of Optometry is making a request to continue Base Level for the 2007-2009 biennium plus a Change Level request of \$2,000 each year of the biennium to provide for increases in telephone and rent of office space.

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Analysis of Budget Request

Appropriation: A27 - Optometry Oprs

Funding Sources: 320-Optometry Board-Cash

The State Board of Optometry is funded with fees charged by the Agency, as authorized by Arkansas Code §17-90-401.

A cost of living increase is not incorporated in Base Level pending the outcome of the Classification and Compensation Study. The Base Level request of \$59,685 each year of the biennium for Regular Salaries does include board member Stipend payments. Personal Services Matching reflects increases in the Base Level due to certain increases in Worker's Compensation and Unemployment Tax rates as well as a \$30 increase in the monthly contribution for State employee's health insurance for a total State match per budgeted employee of \$350 per month.

Base Level for the Board is \$145,207 each year of the biennium and is used to pay regular salaries for two employees as well as provide operating costs for the Board. An additional \$2,000 each year of the biennium is being requested in Operating Expenses. This additional appropriation will be used to pay increases in telephone and rent expenses. Operating Expenses have continued at the Base Level amount of \$26,254 since FY04.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Agency Request. Expenditure of appropriation is contingent upon available funding.
