

**ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM
AGENCY PROGRAM COMMENTARY
2001-2003**

The Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission is funded through industry fees. During the two previous budget cycles extraordinary non-recurring expenses caused the Agency to defer normal budget increase requests.

The Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission has implemented a mandatory manufactured home installer continuing education program. This program expansion has further stretched the Agency's resources. Along with this new program, the Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission is sustaining an elevated installation inspection schedule.

The majority of the requested budget increase in our operating appropriation are in the category of one-time expenditures to support existing programs and services.

The increase request in our Investment and Claims appropriation is in anticipation of the need to meet consumer claims arising from the years of industry expansion which, have evolved into a period of contraction.

Findings

UNACCOUNTED FOR FUNDS - Seventeen (17) cash receipts for the period July 1, 1997 through August 4, 1999, totaling \$4,351.00, were not deposited to agency accounts. Upon discovery of the undeposited receipts on September 13, 1999, audit staff questioned Floyd Worden, custodian of the funds. The following day, he produced an envelope containing \$2,434.00 and stated that he found it in a file in his office. These funds were later deposited. A cash count conducted by audit staff on September 16, 1999 and signed by Floyd Worden, documented that all undeposited cash was made available to the auditors. Subsequent to the cash count, Floyd Worden notified audit staff he had located an additional \$1,817.00 on September 17, 1999 and \$50.00 on September 20, 1999, that was not made available to auditors during the cash count, reducing the initial undeposited, unaccounted for funds to \$50.00.

Recommendations

Strengthen internal controls to provide for an independent reconciliation of cash receipts and deposits.

**ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM
ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST
2001-2003**

The Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission is funded from the receipt of fees charged by the Agency, as authorized by Arkansas Code §20-25-101 et seq. The Commission's request includes Base Level operations of \$316,260 for FY02 and \$322,421 for FY03 includes salaries for seven positions and supporting operating appropriation. Base Level includes a payplan increase of 2.6% each year over the 2001 fiscal year salary levels for all incumbents plus appropriate Personal Services Matching costs. Changes totaling \$44,590 in FY02 and \$21,190 in FY03 have been requested by the Commission.

Requested increases to Operating Expense of \$18,290 in FY02 and \$18,690 in FY03 is to provide for increases in inspection costs of on site installations and to provide for anticipated increases in other operating expenses such as equipment leases, printing, postage and utility costs. The Agency has also added a mandatory continuing education program as part of its Manufactured Home Installation Certificate which will create additional administrative costs. The Agency requested no increases in Operating Expenses the previous biennium.

The Agency is also requesting increases of \$23,800 in FY02 in Capital Outlay to replace a vehicle and purchase office furniture.

An increase of \$2,500 in Data Processing costs each year of the biennium for the replacement of computer equipment has also been requested.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level plus increases of \$5,000 in Operating Expenses each year of the biennium and a \$33,400 increase in Capital Outlay in FY02. The increase to Capital Outlay represents the Agency request of \$23,800 plus \$9,600. The \$9,600 was included in the Agency request as a \$4,800 Operating Expense increase for rental of office equipment in each year of the biennium.

**ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM
ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST
2001-2003**

The Arkansas Manufactured Homes Commission's Investment and Claims Appropriation is funded from the receipt of fees from manufactures, dealers and installers for license renewal. Funds collected are subsequently paid out in the form of actual cost of repairs to qualifying homeowners and as refunds for businesses which have ceased operation. Base Level consists of \$150,000 to provide for claims and refunds. The Agency request is for Base Level plus change requests totaling \$70,100 in FY02 and \$70,200 in FY03 in anticipation of increased claims and refunds in the event of a downturn in the economy.

The Executive Recommendation provides for the Base Level of \$150,000 plus an increase of \$50,000 each year of the biennium.
