Paralegal Position

We are requesting one paralegal position for the next biennium. This position is necessary to aid the attorneys in legal research and case preparation. At present, the attorneys must do all of their own research and prepare all of the necessary motions, pretrial and post-trial briefs, and appellate motions and briefs. With five attorneys to cover seventy-five (75) counties, conducting the requisite exhaustive and extensive research and then drafting the appropriate documents is very difficult. During trials far from Little Rock, it is simply impossible and the attorney must rely on untrained, and otherwise occupied, support staff to try and locate necessary caselaw and authorities. This is certainly not an effective use of time or manpower and leaves the attorneys' and their clients in an often untenable position.

Additionally, having a paralegal on staff would enable the Commission to do more outside research for other public defenders, legislators and various judges around Arkansas. Creating this position would enable the Capital, Conflicts and Appellate office to increase its caseload and enable the Commission to expand and expedite its services. Salary and associated matching costs total \$26, 862 for FY98 and \$27,529 for FY99. Capital Outlay, operating expenses, and conference fees and travel costs associated with this position total \$9,800 for FY98 and \$5,000 for FY99.

Attorney Positions

We are requesting two (2) attorney positions for the next biennium. These two positions are necessary to enable the CCA office to accept more appointments throughout the State. At present we have only five attorneys available to serve all 75 counties of Arkansas. Generally, because of the nature of the cases to which we are appointed, two attorneys must work on each case. Consequently, when considering the amount of time spent on the road and the complexity of the cases, these five attorneys are spread terribly thin. Two more attorney positions would enable us to accept a greater caseload and to better serve the counties throughout the State. Salary and associated matching costs total \$75,720 for FY98 and \$77,670 for FY99. Capital Outlay, operating expenses and conference fees and travel costs associated with these positions total \$26,800 for FY98 and \$17,200 for FY99.

Extra-Help Positions

We are requesting three (3) extra help positions for the next biennium. These positions are so that we may hire law students to work as part-time law clerks during the school year and as full time clerks during the summers. These positions are necessary to assist in research and motion and brief preparation. They would work closely with the paralegal and the attorneys in preparing and completing research projects. These positions are particularly important when the attorneys are in trial in Little Rock or out of town and need research done or issues briefed very quickly. These positions would also benefit the law students by giving them intimate exposure to the criminal justice system. The expenses associated with these positions are: (1) Capital Outlay to set up one office or workstation for FY98 only, \$4,800; (2) General operating expenses for each year of the biennium - \$2,000; (3) Salaries and associated cost of \$12,918 each year.

Rent for Additional Office Space

We are requesting an additional \$15,327 in operating expenses for each year of the biennium to pay the rent for additional office space. This amount represents 1,572 square feet at a rate of \$9.75 per square foot. This space will be needed if we get any of the additional positions requested. If we receive all of the positions requested we will be constructing four additional offices and the nature of the space into which we would be expanding does not lend itself to feasible division. Additionally, one of our current employees needs to have a permanent office. This employee is responsible for all of our transcription and appellate abstract and brief typing. At the present time she is in a high-traffic, partitioned area which makes it very difficult for her to hear the tapes she is transcribing. Further, in the next month or so the office will be having a wheel chair lift installed only inches from her work area. This installation will make it nearly impossible for her to carry out her duties in her present location and, unfortunately, we have nowhere else to put her or any other employees. For these reasons the additional amount in character 02 for operating expenses is essential.

All of the foregoing priority requests, particularly the requests for new positions, are made with the goal of increasing the availability of the CCA office by greatly increasing the caseload which the office can effectively carry, and also increasing the availability of resources the Commission can provide to attorneys, legislators, court personnel and judges throughout Arkansas. With five attorneys and seventy five counties to cover there is a limit to that which we can do, but with an increase of two attorneys, a paralegal and three extra-help positions, we can increase our caseload and availability by 25 to 30 percent.

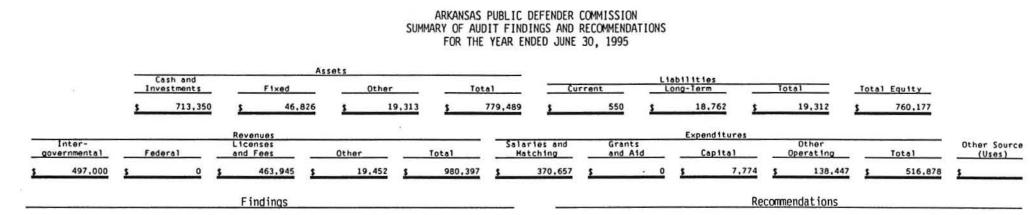
Professional Fees and Services

We are requesting restoration of the FY97 authorized amount of \$96,000.00 each year for Professional Fees and Services. We were forced to tap into the monies allocated to Professional Fees and Services in order to meet the statutorily required deferment, as well as to have adequate funding to cover unexpected expenses in Capital Outlay and Maintenance and Operation over the preceding biennium. Consequently, of the \$96,000.00 originally appropriated, we now have only \$61,879 remaining as a baseline figure for the forthcoming biennium. Therefore, we are requesting an additional amount of \$34,121 in priority programs to restore the original authorization. This will allow our office to effectively represent our clients by providing expert assistance (i.e. psychological/psychiatric, toxicology, firearms, etc.) as needed and to pay for these same types of services in cases pending in other counties where the CCA office was not appointed.

Capital Outlay

We are requesting \$10,000.00 for FY98 and \$7,000.00 for FY99 for Capital Outlay. This money will be needed to upgrade some of our computers which we presently have and to replace some of the monitors which we have that have been problematic. The money will also be used to purchase book shelves for our library and additional file cabinets as needed and a laser printer.

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EXPENDITURE DOCUMENTATION - In two instances, payments for professional services were not supported by invoices or other original evidence of indebtedness. Agency personnel indicated that the original invoices and other supporting documentation were submitted to the Department of Finance and Administration for the issuance of State warrants, and that copies were not retained by the Agency. Additionally, travel expenditures were supported by the carbon copy of the Travel Expense Reimbursement Form (TR-1). Provisions of the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law (Ark. Code Ann. 19-4-1108) provide that original documentation must be retained on file for audit purposes.

ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST 1997 - 1999

The Arkansas Public Defender Commission was established in 1993 to address a variety of problems and concerns related to the representation of indigent criminal defendants in the State of Arkansas. The Commission is funded through the State Central Services Fund. Total requests total \$951,318 for FY98 and \$948,814 for FY99. Of these amounts, \$218,348 for FY98 and \$198,765 for FY99 is requested as priorities above Base Level.

A top priority for the Commission is salary and associated matching costs totaling \$26,862 for FY98 and \$27,529 for FY99 for a Grade 19 Paralegal/Legal Assistant. The primary focus of this position would be on researching legal issues on assigned cases and drafting pre-trial and post-trial briefs for review by the attorneys. Associated M & O for support of this position totals \$9,800 for FY98 and \$5,000 for FY99. Two (2) Grade 24 Attorney positions are also requested to meet the demand for additional legal representation for indigent defendants. Salary and matching costs for these positions total \$75,720 for FY98 and \$77,670 for FY99. For support of these positions, M & O support totaling \$26,800 for FY98 and \$17,200 for FY99 is requested. An additional \$15,327 each year is requested for facility lease costs associated with extra office space only in the event these positions are recommended. The Commission requests an extraordinary increase of approximately 13% for FY98 and an additional 8% for FY99 in salary and accompanying matching requirements for the Grade 99 Executive Director position.

Three (3) Extra Help positions are requested to permit the Commission to hire law students to work as law clerks and assist with research, motion and brief preparation. Personal services and matching costs total \$12,918 each year. Additional M & O support totaling \$6,800 for FY98 and \$2,000 for FY99 is requested for these Extra Help positions. The Commission further requests \$10,000 for FY98 and \$7,000 for FY99 in Capital Outlay for upgrading of computers/monitors, laser printer, and general office equipment. For Professional Fees & Services, \$34,121 is requested to allow for restoration of the FY97 authorized level for each year of the 1997-99 biennium.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level, which includes appropriation for a 2.8% Cost of Living Allowance for positions on July 1 of each year of the biennium along with accompanying employee matching requirements. The Executive Recommendation does not reflect the extraordinary increases requested for the non-classified position at this time.
