Rank Number One, Change Level C10 for \$3,509 in year 2004 and \$4,069 in year 2005 is for a reclassification in the agency grade 14 executive secretary position to a grade 16 Business Controller II position. This position provides all the administrative support for the agency, including accounts payable, payroll, employee benefits and secretarial functions. This position requires significant skils and knowledge of the criminal justice system that far exceeds that of a secretarial position.

Rank Number Two change level C01 is \$35,667 in year 2004 and \$36,630 in year 2005 for a grade 24 attorney position. The Sentencing Commission provides information concerning criminal justice issues to all judges, prosecutors, defense counsel and court personnel throughout the state. The Commission conducts CLE training, provides daily legal research, drafts legislation, revises sentencing guidelines and develops manuals. Presently, the Commission's only attorney is its executive director. The executive director's job duties require significant time out of the office for meetings and training. During legislative sessions, the executive director spends the majority of her time at the State Capitol. The new attorney would assist the director in answering the daily legal questions that arise during her absence, as well as assist in training and development of manuals. Change level C02 request is for \$2,576 in year 2004 for office furnishings and parking for the attorney position.

Rank Number Three, change level C04 is for \$2,502 in each year of the biennium to cover the increase in rental fees charged by State Building Services for office space.

Rank Number Four, change level C03 is for \$5,000 for professional services fees and expenses to provide technical assistance in providing impact assessments on proposed legislation and population projections for the State's correctional resources, including community corrections and prisons.

Rank Number Five change level C05 for \$8,210 in year 2004 and \$6,610 in year 2005 is for miscellaneous operating expenses to cover increased costs of postage, replenish office supplies and costs for conducting data collection throughout the state. In previous years, the Commission has reallocated funds designated for office supplies to other areas.

Change level C08 is for \$8,750 in year 2004 and \$4,030 in year 2005. The increase in year 2004 is for the purchase of data processing equipment and software for the additional position requested in Rank NumberTwo. This change level also includes the cost of maintaining software licenses and maintenance on current equipment and network system.

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The Arkansas Sentencing Commission was established by Act 532 & 550 of 1993 for the purpose of instituting sentencing standards to ensure that sanctions imposed following conviction are proportional to the seriousness of the offense of conviction and the extent of the offender's criminal history. The Commission has developed the sentencing grid, the seriousness reference table and established transfer eligibility for all offenses. The Commission provides impact assessments of proposed legislation for the Governor and General Assembly through a professional service contract with the Institute on Crime, Justice and Correction. This contract also has provided training to the staff of the Sentencing Commission and the Department of Correction in the use of a software program that is utilized in data analysis of criminal justice laws, policies and procedures. The Commission consists of nine (9) Commissioners that are appointed by the Governor for a five-year term.

This is the primary operating appropriation of the Commission. It is funded entirely by General Revenue.

The Base Level request includes a 2.7% salary increase each year over the FY03 salary levels for all incumbents plus associated increases in Personal Services Matching. Included in Personal Services Matching is a \$33 per month increase in the monthly contribution for State employee's health insurance for a total state contribution of \$280 per month per budgeted employee.

The Base Level Request is \$290,801 in FY04 and \$296,435 in FY05.

The Change Level Requests submitted are \$ 77,400 in FY04 and \$ 68,494 in FY05 and are summarized as follows:

- 1. Reclassification of one (1) position from grade 14 to a grade 16 with an increase in salary and match of \$ 3,017 in FY04 and \$ 3,098 in FY05.
- A new grade 24 Attorney Position with \$ 45,344 in FY04 and \$ 46,477 in FY05 for Salary and Personal Service Match, \$ 6,826 in FY04 and \$ 1,356 in FY05 for Operating Expenses related to the new position. This includes office furniture, computer, software, network expense, telephone and parking.

- 3. Operating Expense of \$16,212 in FY04 and \$ 11,562 in FY05 for increases in postage, office and equipment rent, software license maintenance and Commissioners' travel expenses to attend meetings.
- 4. Conference Fees & Travel of \$ 1,000 each year respectively to attend training seminars.
- 5. Professional Fees and Services \$ 5,000 each year respectively for cost associated with The Institute of Crime, Justice and Correction contract.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Base Level and total Change Level requests of \$11,341 in FY04 and \$19,294 in FY05 in funding and appropriation. This Change Level total includes recommendation for a reclassification of one (1) position an Executive Secretary/Administrative Secretary Grade 14 to a Business Controller I Grade 15 with \$1,341 in FY04 and \$1,376 in FY05 for Salary and Personal Services Matching cost. Also recommended is Operating Expenses of \$10,000 in FY04 and \$12,918 in FY05 and \$5,000 for Professional Fees and Services in FY05 only. The Professional Fees and Services will allow the Agency to expand the contract with The Institute of Crime, Justice and Correction to include parole and probation population data.
