### ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM AGENCY PROGRAM COMMENTARY 1999 - 2001

The budget request for the 1999-01 biennium for the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System (APERS), the Arkansas State Police Retirement System (ASPRS) and the Arkansas Judicial Retirement System (AJRS) is totally funded from the investment earnings of the respective Trust Funds. The request will be Base Level, i.e., the FY 99 operational budget, with the following changes:

1. Regular Salaries and Staffing – APERS is requesting that a Retirement Counselor position (Grade 19) approved from the Governor's Supplemental positions for FY 99 for the Member Services Section be approved as a permanent full-time position, and that one Accounting Technician I (Grade 12) position lost to the CAP be restored. APERS is not requesting restoration of (2) Secretary I (Grade 11) and (1) Reporting Specialist I (Grade 11) positions lost to the CAP.

Justification: The Retirement Counselor position will be used as a direct service position for the benefit of the members. The number of members who retire each month is steadily increasing and counselors must also provide additional assistance to those members entering the Deferred Retirement Option Plan (DROP) which was approved during the last session. The position lost to the CAP is clerical in nature and needs to be retained for flexibility to meet unanticipated needs. The Agency is currently at 100% of CAP.

- 2. Extra Help An increase of \$3,000 per year is requested.
- 3. Maintenance & General Operations No change is requested.
- 4. Capital Outlay APERS requests \$152,085 in FY 99-00 and \$31,000 in FY 00-01.

**Justification:** \$142,085 is requested in FY 99-00 for the replacement of data processing equipment ((1) server with 4 processors, 2 GB RAM & 24 GB Hard Drive; networking equipment-(3) Hubs; (35) personal computers and peripheral equipment; (8) 21" monitors) as specified in the APERS Information Technology Plan submitted to and approved by DIS. An additional \$10,000 is requested for FY 99-00 for the routine replacement of various office furniture. \$31,000 is requested for FY 00-01 for the replacement of an agency vehicle and the routine replacement of various office furniture.

- 5. Conference Fees and Travel No change is requested.
- 6. **Professional Fees** A reduction of \$152,085 in FY 99-00 and \$31,000 in FY 00-01 is requested to reallocate resources for the Capital Outlay request.

7. Cash Fund Appropriations (Benefits-Char. 13) – APERS requests an increase of \$10,000,000 in each fiscal year and ASPRS requests an increase of \$1,000,000 in each fiscal year.

Justification: These requests are due to increases in the number of retirees opting for direct deposit of retirement benefits.

8. **Operational Appropriations (Benefits-Char. 23)** – APERS requests a decrease of \$25,000,000 in each fiscal year; ASPRS requests a decrease of \$12,000,000 in each fiscal year and AJRS requests a decrease of \$1,500,000 in each fiscal year.

Justification: These requests are due to decreases in the number of retirees opting for payment of retirement benefits by state warrant.

The Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System administers the Public Employees Retirement System, the State Police Retirement System, and the Judicial Retirement System. Each retirement system has a separate Board of Trustees. The Public Employees Retirement System and the State Police Retirement System have both contributory and non-contributory provisions. The Judicial Retirement System is a contributory system.

The objective of each system is to provide present and future retirement or survivor benefits by paying from regular income instead of contributions or anticipated appreciation of investments.

The expenses of each of the retirement systems are paid from the investment income of that system. In addition, special language allows the Public Employees Retirement System to assess the Judicial Retirement System and the State Police Retirement System for administrative costs. For 1998-99 the assessment is \$17,500 for the Judicial Retirement System and \$29,225 for the State Police Retirement System. For the 1999-01 biennium, the System is requesting that the assessments be increased to \$18,025 in 1999-00 and \$18,565 in 2000-01 for the Judicial Retirement System and \$30,102 in 1999-00 and \$31,005 in 2000-01 for the State Police Retirement System. This represents a 3% increase each year.

The System is requesting two positions above Base Level for the 1999-01 biennium. However, these two positions are not new positions but consist of one position (Accounting Technician I) which was not budgeted due to the Personnel Cap, and one position (Retirement Counselor) authorized through Supplemental Personal Services procedures for FY99. The Accounting position is to provide additional clerical support as needed, and the Retirement Counselor will provide assistance to the increasing number of retiring members of the System and those members specifically interested in the Deferred Retirement Option Plan (DROP).

Base Level for salaries includes a cost of living increase of 2.8% each year over the FY99 salary levels, and related Personal Services Matching costs. Career Ladder Incentive Program (CLIP) requests total \$2,769 in FY00 and \$2,846 in FY01. These requests include data processing, reporting specialist and accounting positions.

An additional \$3,000 each year is requested in Extra Help to allow the System to use former employees who have knowledge of the system to help with various clerical tasks during peak periods.

A reduction of \$152,085 in FY00 and \$31,000 in FY01 for Professional Fees and Services is requested to reallocate resources to provide for the Capital Outlay request.

The Capital Outlay request consists of \$142,085 in FY00 for data processing equipment as outlined in their Technology Plan submitted and approved by the Department of Information Systems. An additional \$10,000 in FY00 would be used to replace office furniture and equipment. For FY01, \$31,000 is requested to replace a vehicle and for routine replacement of office furniture and equipment.

The System is requesting a reduction of \$25,000,000 each year in Investments/Benefits/Refunds based upon the decreasing number of retirees who choose to receive payment of retirement benefits by state warrant. More retirees are opting for direct deposit of benefit payments.

This appropriation is funded from trust funds for Public Employees Retirement and by assessments to the Judicial Retirement System and the State Police Retirement System for administrative expenses.
