ARKANSAS GEOLOGICAL COMMISSION

The Arkansas Geological Commission (AGC) was created by Act 16 of 1963. Agency activities are divided into three major sections: 1) Administrative Services, 2) Technical Services, and 3) Informational Services. The activities are primarily supported by General Revenue Funds, except Map and Publication Sales which operate on a revolving fund, the Geology Learning Center, which is funded from donations, and the State Geological Mapping Program (STATEMAP) which receives a miscellaneous federal grant.

The Administrative Services Section supports the AGC with administrative, accounting, personnel, and secretarial services. An additional \$5,000 per fiscal year is required to meet expected increases in building maintenance and utilities. In order to restore funding levels of the previous biennium, additional funds of \$8,000 per fiscal year is needed in Extra Help.

The Technical Services Section (Geologic Staff) provides information on geology, mineral resources, and geohydrology of the State to the general public, other government agencies, and industry through the preparation, publication and distribution of geologic maps and reports. This activity encourages the orderly development of the State's mineral, fossil fuel (oil natural gas, coal and lignite), and ground water resources through geochemical, geophysical and geological studies, and core drilling. Current geologic map coverage of the State is maintained and other geologic studies are conducted as needed. The geologic information compiled and maintained for these investigations is necessary for exploration, development, planning and protection for the mineral resources base of Arkansas and as the framework for numerous environmental studies. A technical support group assists the geologic staff in collecting, evaluating and preparing geologic data. This group includes the Drilling Operation, Chemical Laboratory, and Well Sample Library. The Drilling Operation provides necessary subsurface data to specific investigations. The Chemical Laboratory provides for preparation and analysis of mineral samples. The Well Sample Library has an inventory of cores and cuttings from more than 5,000 wells drilled in Arkansas. An increase in appropriation of \$2,000 in FY04 is needed in Maintenance and Operation appropriation to purchase field equipment for geologists and a \$7,000 Capital Outlay request in FY05 for lab equipment to be used in the rock sample preparation and chemistry laboratories. In order to restore cuts from the previous biennial budget cuts, a request of \$16,000 per fiscal year is needed in the mineral exploration program.

The AGC has four cooperative programs with the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Mid-Continent Mapping Center and Water Resources Division. The cooperative program with the Mid-Continent Mapping Center provides Arkansas with updated topographic maps and cartographic information, and enables the state to be an affiliate of the Earth Science Information Center. The State has complete coverage of 7.5-minute topographic quadrangles and these funds are used to revise and update older maps. No additional funds are requested for this program above base level. Three cooperative programs with the U.S. Geological Survey's Water Resources Division include 1) Stream Gauging Program (surface water), 2) Water Quality Program, and 3) Ground Water Survey. These programs provide for collecting, evaluating and developing data relating to the State's surface and ground water resources. Information from these programs is important to the development and protection of the State's water supply and is critical to the agencies that regulate and manage the State's water resources. Specifically, these funds are used to collect and analyze surface and ground water samples (Water Quality Program); installation and monitoring of continuous-record stream gauging stations (Stream Gauging Program); and research in subsurface geology relating to ground water (Ground Water Survey). The Ground Water Survey will include regular water-level measurements of wells in the critical Sparta Aquifer in south Arkansas and the Quaternary Aquifer in east Arkansas. In order to restore funds cut in the previous biennium a request for \$14,000 per FY is needed in the Ground Water Program, \$10,000 per FY in the Stream Gauging Program, and \$5,174 per FY in the Water Quality Program. All four programs receive an equal amount of federal funds.

The Information Services Section's primary functions are preparation, storage and distribution of data, reports, and maps prepared and maintained by the AGC. This is accomplished through the Map and Publication Sales Office, Geographic Information System and Cartography Office, Geological Library, Printing Office, Earth Science Information Center, and reception and telephone services. The Geology Learning Center (GLC), which is part of this section, has a separate appropriation.

The following requests are made to enable the agency to provide geologic and natural resource information to the public and other government agencies in an electronic format and participate in the electronic accounting program AASIS. A Capital Outlay request of \$30,000 in FY04 is for an agency network (LAN) designed by the Department of Information Technology (DIS). An increase of \$8,500 per fiscal year in Maintenance and Operations is needed for DIS operating and line costs of the agency network LAN system. A request in Professional Fees and Services for \$10,000 in FY04 is needed for the installation and training of the network by DIS. An increase of \$5,000 per fiscal year is needed in Maintenance and Operation to continue the scheduled replacement of five agency computers per year (this allows a minimum of five years life expectancy per computer). All of these requests are part of the technology needs based on the agency Information Technology Plan (IT). A request in salaries and matching is needed to restore funding to a clerk typist position that was cut in budget reductions of the previous biennium. An increase in salaries and matching of \$21,863 in FY04 and \$22,362 in FY05 is needed.

MAP RESALE

The Map Resale appropriation provides for the authorization to spend a portion of the money collected from the sale of maps and publications and reproduction charges. No tax monies are involved, as this simply constitutes authorization to spend monies collected in FY 04 and FY 05.

STATEMAP - STATE GEOLOGIC MAPPING PROGRAM

The funds for STATEMAP (State Geologic Mapping Program) are federal funds (USGS) which pay for the salary of one field geologist to conduct geologic field studies and mapping in Arkansas. The program involves the geologic mapping of areas of the state selected by the Commission. This is a cooperative effort between the AGC and the USGS and is part of the National Geologic Mapping effort to standardize the quality of geologic mapping in the United States. This project will aid in the development and management of the mineral resources of the area and greatly expand the knowledge of the geology of the State.

MUSEUM EXPENSES (GEOLOGY LEARNING CENTER) - CASH

This appropriation provides for the authorization to spend money donated to the AGC Geology Learning Center (GLC). The GLC is part of the educational arm of the agency with the purpose of giving student and citizens of all ages exposure to rocks, minerals, fossils, and fossil fuels. The GLC has 5 display areas and receives funding and exhibit material from donations. There are no priority requests for this appropriation above base level.

The Arkansas Geological Commission's appropriation for State Operations is funded entirely by general revenues. In this program, data is accumulated, analyzed, and disseminated to provide knowledge of the geology and hydrogeology of the State to stimulate orderly development and encourage effective management and utilization of the State's mineral, fossil fuel, and water resources in an environmentally responsible manner. The Base Level request includes a 2.7% salary increase each year over the FY03 salary levels for all incumbents plus associated increases in Personal Services Matching. Included in Personal Services Matching is a \$33 per month increase in the monthly contribution for State employee's health insurance for a total state contribution of \$280 per month per budgeted employee.

An increase of \$5,000 is requested in Operating Expenses for FY04 for anticipated repairs to buildings. An additional request of \$2,000 in FY04 and \$1,000 in FY05 is also being requested in Operating Expenses for the replacement and updating of field equipment used in the geologic mapping program.

A Capital Outlay request of \$7,000 in FY05 is needed to purchase lab equipment for the rock and chemical lab used by Technical staff in mapping and mineral investigation activities.

In accordance with the Commission's Information Technology Plan, as submitted to the Office of Information Technology, Capital Outlay of \$30,000 for FY04 is requested to upgrade or replace data processing equipment, increases in Operating Expenses of \$8,500 each year are requested for line charges and network costs, and another \$5,000 in Operating Expenses is requested each year to replace agency computers. Professional Fees & Services of \$10,000 in the first year is requested for installation and programming assistance.

The cooperative water data programs with the US Geological Survey Water Resources Division include the Water Quality Program, Stream Gauging Program, Mineral Exploration Program, and the Ground Water Survey Program. These programs collect and analyze surface and ground water samples, monitor stream flow, research and evaluate the mineral resources in the state, and research subsurface geology relating to groundwater. Restoration of funding of \$45,174 in each year of the biennium is requested for these programs to bring them back to levels previously authorized.

Salary and matching of \$21,863 in FY04 and \$22,362 in FY05 are being requested for the restoration of a clerk typist. Extra Help and

These proceeds are deposited into the Agency's revolving fund, as authorized in A.C.A. § 19-4-1804. The Base Level request includes a 2.7% salary increase each year over the FY03 salary levels for all incumbents plus associated increases in Personal Services Matching. Included in Personal Services Matching is a \$33 per month increase in the monthly contribution for State employee's health insurance for a total state contribution of \$280 per month per budgeted employee. Continuation at Base Level is the Agency Request for this program.

The Executive Recommendation provides for the Agency Request.
