Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute requests funding as generated by Funding Formula approved by State Board of Workforce Education and as required by Act 1158 of 1999. The funding formula also reflects accountability measures and performance indicators as requested under Performance Based Budgeting. The Funding Formula generates funding based upon student enrollment, business and industry contact hours and the students obtaining their educational objectives. The additional funding generated by the Funding Formula would allow the agency to provide expanded training programs to our service area as well as industry specific training. The area businesses and industries are requiring additional training for their employees. Presently, classes are being offered at several industrial plants and the Federal Correctional Facility. The funding would also allow the agency to expand its information technology to support the state information project (AASIS).

Reclassification of the administrative positions would give the local board control and flexibility in setting salaries and duties of the administrative staff as directed under Section 9 of Act 803 of 1997. This act gives the local boards the powers and duties as necessary for the management and administration of the technical institute.

A librarian position is requested in order for the agency to meet North Central Association accreditation. Additional positions are requested to allow growth and flexibility in providing services to enhance the operations of the agency. Additional extra help positions are requested to replace the part-time faculty positions. Many of our classes are short-term in nature requiring an extra help position instead of the part-time faculty positions. The part-time faculty positions should be eliminated due to the high cost of benefits for them.

Contingencies are requested in each fund to allow the agency to respond to the unexpected needs of business and industry. Contingency positions are requested to allow the agency flexibility in hiring staff to meet the needs of industry.

The restoration of capital equipment appropriation in the cash fund is requested for the emergency needs of the training programs.

Additional conference fees and travel appropriation and maintenance and operation appropriation is requested for the state fund. Workforce 2000 funding has been utilized for Maintenance & Operation due to the shortage of funding from General Revenues.

To summarize, additional funding and appropriation is requested to provide competitive training programs to meet the demands of business and industry.

ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST 2001 - 2003

Funds for this appropriation are received from tuition (\$30 to approximately \$35 per hour), resale from the bookstore, and reimbursement programs such as Apprenticeship. Cash funds are used to supplement the operations of the agency.

Base Level includes positions and supporting operating expenses. The Base Level includes a pay plan increase of 2.6% each year over the FY01 salary levels, and related Personal Services Matching costs.

Change Level requests include Capital Outlay for new and replacement equipment and Contingency appropriation to respond to the needs of business and industry, and a reallocation of Part Time Faculty positions to Extra Help. During the 82nd General Assembly, the number of Extra Help positions were reduced and Part Time Faculty positions were authorized in their place. A change in the method of collecting the State's retirement contribution, which is based on the number of positions budgeted, made it fiscally impossible to budget many of these positions. As a result of the expense for insurance associated with regular positions, no Part Time Faculty positions were included in the request, and the reallocation of funds for Extra Help will allow the Institute to provide needed services.

The Executive Recommendation provides for the Agency Request with the exception of Contingency appropriation. Operating income for this appropriation may not meet projected levels depending upon the number of requests by business and industry for training.

ANALYSIS OF BUDGET REQUEST 2001 - 2003

Crowley's Ridge strives to respond to the business and industry needs in Forrest City and the West Memphis areas. Advances in computer technology is an emphasis, as well as responding to in-plant training needs.

The Base Level for this General Revenue funded appropriation includes positions and supporting operating expenses. During the 82nd General Assembly, Extra Help positions were exchanged for Part Time Faculty positions. This resulted in a much higher cost than anticipated when the method of collecting the State's insurance contribution was calculated based on budgeted positions. For this reason, the Institute is requesting Extra Help positions in exchange for Part Time Faculty positions in the Change Level request. No Part Time Faculty positions are requested for the biennium. Additional requests include Operating Expenses and Capital Outlay to respond to the rapidly changing technologies used in the diversified marketplace in which our workers must compete, and Travel for staff development. Contingency appropriation is requested to allow the Institute to meet unforeseen needs from the business community. Various personnel request are made, including seventeen additional positions for administrative purposes such as record-keeping, recruitment, and financial aid, as well as positions for transportation and maintenance. Reclass requests for administrative positions are also requested.

The Executive Recommendation provides for the reallocation of positions to Extra Help, the request for Capital Outlay, and a 5% increase above the Base Level each year for Operating Expenses. All recommendations above the Base Level are for appropriation only. Workforce 2000 funds are also made available to the Institute and will supplement the funds seen in this budget. Current law provides for appropriation and funding for Workforce 2000 to be transferred to the Institute on a monthly basis. The Institute is encouraged to engage the local communities and businesses it serves by developing a partnership to meet the local workforce education needs with emphasis on accountability and productivity. Local contributions along with state resources can provide a significant enhancement of the instructional programs.
