



ARKANSAS INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX APRIL 15 FILING AND PAYMENT DEADLINE EXTENDED TO MAY 17 DUE TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Due to the ongoing public health emergency related to the novel Coronavirus/COVID-19, the Governor has signed Executive Order 21-06 directing the Department of Finance and Administration to extend the April 15 deadline for filing and payment of the following Arkansas Individual Income Tax returns to May 17, 2021:

- 2020 Individual Income Tax Now Due: 5/17/2021
 - 2020 Subchapter S Corporations Now Due: 5/17/2021
 - 2020 Fiduciary and Estates Now Due: 5/17/2021
 - 2020 Partnership Income Tax Now Due: 5/17/2021
 - 2020 Composite Returns Now Due: 5/17/2021
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- The extension to May 17, 2021 is automatic and the taxpayer does not need to file for an extension.
 - The April 15, 2021 to May 17, 2021 period will be disregarded for purposes of calculation of interest and penalties. Interest and penalties will begin to accrue on May 18, 2020.
 - This extension does not apply to 2021 estimated Individual Income Tax payments due on April 15 or June 15.

The following filing and payment deadlines for income tax are not affected:

- 2020 Corporation Income Tax Due: 4/15/2021
- 2021 Estimated Tax Payment Due: 4/15/2021
- 2021 Estimated Tax Payment Due: 6/15/2021

No extension is provided in this notice for the payment or deposit of any other type of Arkansas State tax including but not limited to:

- Sales and Use Tax
- Withholding Tax
- Motor Fuels Tax
- Tobacco Products Tax
- Alcohol Excise
