#### PROGRAM DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION

The applicant must provide a detailed narrative on how the applicant will implement specific program strategies that will impact the selected PSN goal(s) for this funded project. The narrative must include the selected goal(s) and describe what strategies and/or activities are to be implemented as well as describe any models that will be utilized to response to the problem. Applicant must include a project timeline and/or task action plan. The program specific strategies may include but not limited to: (1) conducting investigations; (2) conducting and receiving additional training; (3) conducting undercover investigations; (4) utilizing and accessing the National Integrated Ballistics Intelligence Network (NIBIN); and (5) information sharing and education for building and referring a case for federal.

- (4) demonstrate experience addressing gun and gang violence, and gang violence associated with conflict over turf, narcotics distribution, aggression and shootings
- (5) demonstrate experience working with law enforcement, criminal justice agencies and community-based partners on targeted enforcement, prevention activities, community engagement, and accountability within a planned and implemented strategy
- (6) must describe its project staff indicating who will be responsible for carrying and overseeing the project implementation
