Manufacturing time varies. You will be notified by mail, phone, or email when your license plate has arrived.

Requests for personalized plates are ordered after all fees are paid. The plates are normally available within four (4) weeks of the department's order date.

If you chose to pick up your license plate, you will be notified when your plate is available with instructions to obtain your license plate.

## Not Allowed for Personalized License Plates

1. Combination of characters that will conflict with the regular numbering system of any license plate.
2. Word or letter combinations that exceed seven (7) characters and spaces combined.
3. Word or letter combinations that are suggestive, offensive, or not in good taste.
4. The use of interchangeable characters, symbols, and signs. e.g., period (.), plus sign (+), dash (-), the letter Q , etc.

## Restrictions

1. Issuance of personalized plates is restricted to passenger cars, $1 / 2$ ton and $3 / 4$ ton pickups, and 1 -ton trucks used for private transportation only.
2. Personalized plates of this classification plates may not consist of more than seven (7) characters and spaces combined.
3. Applicants may request three combinations in priority of choice. If none of the choices are available, the fee and application will be returned to the applicant.
4. After a choice has been submitted and accepted by the department, there cannot be any changes to the request and a refund will not be granted.

Amateur Radio license plates can only be placed on a vehicle that is registered in the same name as the FCC license holder and a copy of the FCC license must accompany this request.
