Dear Secretary Walther:

With regard to Act 1020 of the 93rd General Assembly Regular Session, 2021—The Transparency in Foreign Investment Act, the following statements are true concerning the University of Arkansas Criminal Justice Institute:

- A. The University of Arkansas Criminal Justice Institute has not accepted a gift from a foreign source or entered into a contract with a foreign source.
- B. The University of Arkansas Criminal Justice Institute has not received a gift from a foreign source valued at more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).
- C. The University of Arkansas Criminal Justice Institute has not entered into a contract with a foreign source valued at more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).
- D. The University of Arkansas Criminal Justice Institute has not received multiple gifts from foreign sources affiliated with the same foreign government that the aggregate value of the gifts is more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).
- E. The University of Arkansas Criminal Justice Institute has not received multiple contracts from foreign sources affiliated with the same foreign government that the aggregate value of the contracts is more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).
