

**ARKANSAS BUDGET SYSTEM
AGENCY PROGRAM COMMENTARY
1997 - 1999**

The budget request for the 1997-99 biennium for the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System (APERS), the Arkansas State Police Retirement System (ASPRS), and the Arkansas Judicial Retirement System (AJRS) is totally funded from the investment earnings of the respective Trust Funds. The request will be Base Level, i.e., the FY97 operational budget, with the following changes:

1. Regular Salaries and Staffing - APERS is requesting that the Assistant Director and Associate Director of Investments positions be changed to an unclassified status (Grade 99). In addition, APERS is requesting that the Member Services Manager position be upgraded to a Grade 23. APERS is requesting one additional position for the Data Processing Section, a User Support Analyst (Grade 20), and that the two positions lost to the cap be restored.

Justification: The request to change to unclassified or line item the Assistant Director and Associate Director positions is to give the agency director the flexibility to recruit, retain, and compensate these positions according to their responsibilities. The request to upgrade the Member Services Manager is to bring this position to the same grade level as all other manager positions. The additional data processing position will be used to maintain the new employer reporting system and to help maintain the local area network that has been installed in the last twelve months. The two positions lost to the cap are clerical in nature and need to be retained for flexibility to meet unanticipated needs. The agency has maintained a staffing level between 37 and 44 positions for a number of years. This level should remain the same. The agency needs the ability to use different types of positions to meet specific requirements.

2. Maintenance and General Operations - An increase of 2.5% each year is requested for ASPRS and AJRS. For APERS, the request is an additional \$83,000 for the first year of the biennium and \$92,000 for the second year.

Justification: The increases requested for APERS are primarily for the postage, printing and distribution of a newsletter to members and retirees. This newsletter will be mailed three times a year and should greatly enhance communications with members and retirees. In addition, APERS is requesting a minimal increase for rent of office space. APERS is located in One Union National Plaza which is owned by the Retirement System as an investment. As such, the agency pays rent like any other tenant. The increases requested for ASPRS and AJRS are to meet inflationary costs.

3. Capital Outlay - APERS is requesting \$26,000 for each year of the biennium.

Justification: Capital Outlay is requested for the purchase of mailing equipment (12 years old and constantly in need of servicing), replacement of some of the older personal computers and printers, purchase of a network server, purchase of equipment for on-site counseling, and replacement of minor furniture items.

4. Professional Fees - AJRS is requesting an increase of \$30,450 for the first year of the biennium and \$39,029 for the second year of the biennium.

Justification: The requested increases represent projected increases in the value of the portfolio for the investment manager; normal inflation and additional cost studies for the actuary; and normal inflation for the investment consultant. No increase is requested for the custodian bank or the direct deposit bank.

5. Cash Fund Appropriations for Benefit Payments - APERS, ASPRS, and AJRS are requesting sufficient increases in these appropriations to pay all benefits from the cash fund appropriations. These payments would be made by direct deposit and by check as authorized by A.C.A. 24-3-409.

Justification: Currently, direct deposit benefit payments are made from the cash fund appropriation using a bank fund. Those benefit recipients not on direct deposit are paid by state warrant. Paying the non-direct deposit recipient by check using a bank fund will be a more efficient method. The Systems will be able to reissue lost payments within a few days instead of weeks, and it will eliminate staff time required to record, stuff and mail state warrant. It appears that the cost to the Systems to process all benefit payments through a bank fund will not exceed current costs. There could actually be a cost savings, but that is not determinable at this time.

The Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System is requesting \$4,000,000 in FY98 and \$5,000,000 in FY99 for the cash appropriation to allow the Agency to pay all benefits of the Judicial Retirement System through the cash fund. Currently, benefits that are paid by direct deposit are processed through the cash fund while benefits paid by warrant are processed through the State Treasury. Processing all benefit payments through the cash fund will enable the system to reduce the amount of time necessary to replace lost checks and also allow the System to continue to earn interest while the payments are in transit.

The request represents a \$500,000 increase for FY98 and a \$1,500,000 increase for FY99.

The Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System administers the Public Employees Retirement System, the State Police Retirement System, and the Judicial Retirement System. Each retirement system has a separate Board of Trustees. The Public Employees Retirement System and the State Police Retirement System have both contributory and non-contributory provisions. The Judicial Retirement System is a contributory system.

The objective of each system is to provide present and future retirement or survivor benefits by paying from regular income instead of contributions or anticipated appreciation of investments.

The expenses of each of the retirement systems are paid from the investment income of that system. In addition, special language allows the Public Employees Retirement System to assess the Judicial Retirement System and the State Police Retirement System for administrative costs. For 1996-97 the assessment is \$16,500 for the Judicial Retirement System and \$27,550 for the State Police Retirement System. For the 1997-99 biennium, the System is requesting that the assessments be increased to \$17,000 in 1997-98 and \$17,500 in 1998-99 for the Judicial Retirement System and \$28,375 in 1997-98 and \$29,225 in 1998-99 for the State Police Retirement System. This represents a 3% increase each year.

Priority requests for the 1997-99 biennium total \$199,831 for FY98 and \$211,120 for FY99.

Priority requests for personnel are to restore two currently authorized positions which could not be budgeted because of the personnel cap restrictions. These positions are an Accounting Technician (Grade 12) and a Reporting Specialist I (Grade 11). Salary and matching costs for these two positions would be \$37,552 for FY98 and \$38,434 for FY99.

One new position is requested, a User Support Analyst (Grade 20) to maintain the new employer reporting system and to assist with the local area network which has been installed in the past twelve months. The cost on this would be \$29,944 in FY98 and \$30,698 in FY99.

Additional personnel requests include changing the PERS Assistant Director and the Associate Director - Investments to Grade 99 positions. Also, they are requesting an upgrade of the APERS Member Services Manager from a Grade 22 to a Grade 23 to bring this position in line with the other manager positions.

Priority requests for Operating Expenses total \$83,000 for FY98 and \$92,000 for FY99. The most significant item in the request is \$73,000 each year for printing and distribution of a newsletter to be sent out three times a year. The additional request is for a slight increase in rent.

Priority requests for Capital Outlay are \$26,000 each year. This would purchase mailing equipment to replace 12-year-old equipment, replace obsolete computers and printers, purchase a network server, and replace some furniture items.

This appropriation is funded from trust funds for Public Employees Retirement and by assessments to the Judicial Retirement System and the State Police Retirement System for administrative expenses.

The Executive Recommendation provides for Agency Request and includes appropriation for a 2.8% Cost of Living Allowance for positions on July 1 of each year of the biennium along with accompanying employee matching requirements. The Executive Recommendation does not address agency requests for Upgrade/Reclassification of positions at this time.
