BOARD MEETING MINUTES June 06, 2024

The Arkansas Tobacco Control Board met on Thursday, June 6, 2024, for its monthly meeting in the Main Street Mall Building, located at 101 E. Capitol Avenue, Little Rock, Arkansas, beginning at 10:00 a.m. in Suite 119. There were six (6) Board members present.

Board Members Present: Chairman Gary Proffitt, Dr. Patricia Knott via Zoom, Mr. Brandon Mickinney, David Hendrix, Jr., Mr. Brent Summerhill, and Dr. Shabbir Dharamsey (left after the hearings).

CALL TO ORDER.

- Chairman Gary Proffitt called the ATC Board meeting to order and opened the meeting welcoming the guests and staff.
- There were two hearings set for today's Board Meeting. As a result, a hearing officer, Mr. Craig Smith, and court reporter, Ms. Nicole Neal, were present.

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Gary Proffitt requested a motion to approve the board meeting minutes from May 02, 2024. A motion was made by Dr. Shabbir Dharamsey and seconded by Mr. David Hendrix, Jr. to approve the May 02, 2024, minutes. It passed with six (6) yes votes and zero (0) opposing votes.

NEW RETAIL PERMITS ISSUED

- Director Christy Bjornson requested the Board members to review and approve the list of fiftyeight (58) new permits (those permits other than wholesale permits) issued from May 1, 2024
 through May 30, 2024.
- A motion was made to accept and approve the list of fifty-eight (58) new permits issued by Mr. David Hendrix, Jr. and seconded by Mr. Brent Summerhill. The motion passed with five (5) yes votes and zero (0) opposing votes.

ACCEPTED OFFERS OF SETTLEMENT

 Director Christy Bjornson requested the Board members to review and approve the list of Accepted Offers of Settlement for the month of May 2024 A motion was made to accept the Accepted Offers of Settlement by Dr Shabbir Dharamsey and seconded by Mr David Hendrix, Jr The motion passed with six (6) yes votes and zero (0) opposing votes

FDA Agents completed 28 follow-up Inspections with 0potential violations resulting in a 0 % violation rate for the month of May 2024.

FULL HEARINGS

Case No 2023-12043 AUGUSTA EXPRESS, LLC - Permit No 05308-04 Amit Budhwani 105 HWY 64 East Augusta, AR 72006

Violations (1) Selling Below Minimum - A C A § 4-75-708(a)

- (2) No Server Awareness Form ATC Rule 4 1
- (3) Failure to Maintain Invoices for 3 Years A C A § 26-57-213

In light of the evidence and testimony submitted before the Board, a motion was made by Mr. Brent Summerhill and seconded by Dr. Shabbir Dharamsey to keep the recommended penalty of \$2,000.00 civil penalty and fifteen (15) day permit suspension for violation of A.C.A. § 26-57-213, a \$100.00 civil penalty for the violation of ATC Rule 4.1., and a \$200.00 civil penalty for the violation of A.C.A. § 4-75-708(a). Motion passed with five (5) yes votes and zero (0) opposing votes. *Chairman Gary Proffitt recused himself from this particular hearing. *

In light of the evidence and testimony submitted before the Board, a motion was made by Mr. Brent Summerhill and seconded by Mr. David Hendrix, Jr. to keep the recommended penalty of \$1,000.00 civil penalty, ten (10) day permit suspension, to be held in abeyance pending no further violations for two years, for the violation of violation of A.C.A. § 26-57-228. Motion passed with six (6) yes votes and zero (0) opposing votes.

 Chairman Gary Proffitt asked if there were any questions or comments from the Board members. There were no questions or comments made at that time.

ADJOURNMENT

In closing, Chairman Gary Proffitt stated that the next ATC Board meeting is scheduled for July 11, 2024. A motion was made by Chairman Gary Proffitt and seconded by Mr. David Hendrix, Jr. to adjourn. It was approved with five (5) yes votes and zero (0) opposing votes. The meeting was adjourned.
