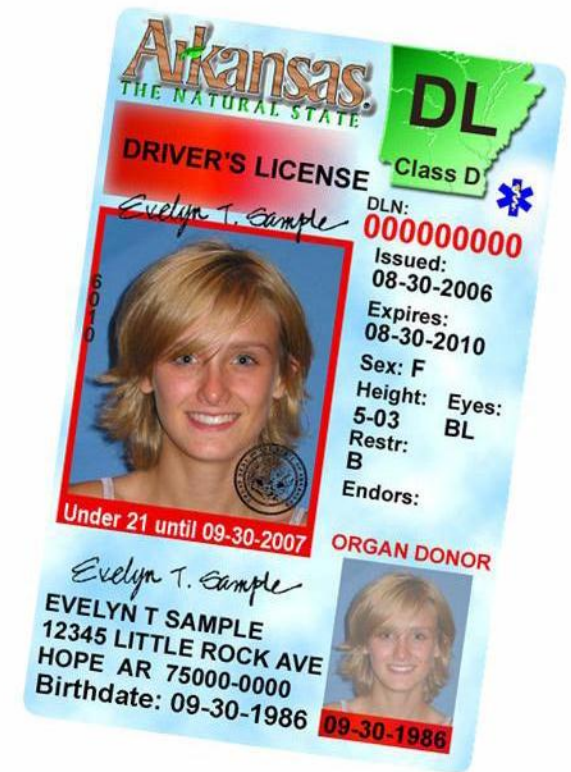

New format...



Vertical!

Beginning December 11, 2006, Arkansas will start issuing drivers licenses and IDs in a new vertical or portrait format.

This change will immediately distinguish cards issued to minors to ease control of alcohol and tobacco sales.

New Style Features

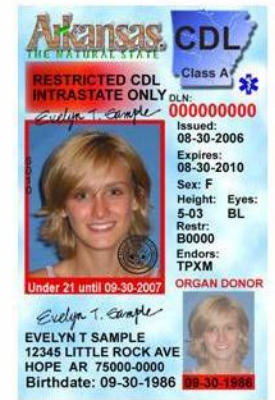
Old style



Old style under 18/21 cards will remain valid until their printed expiration date.



"Under 21 until MM-DD-YYYY" Birthdate is repeated across the bottom of the card appears in white text on red under the portrait. If the customer was under 18 at the time of issuance, "Under 18 until MM-DD-YYYY" in black text on yellow is also displayed.



No commercial driving documents are issued to drivers under age 18.



Arkansas state map is displayed following a color-code, based on type: CDL-Blue, DL—Green, ID—Red, Intermediate License—Yellow, Learner's License—White.
